Introduction

This report contains the average composite, English, mathematics, reading, and science reasoning American College Test (ACT) scores at both the district and school levels. These scores were averaged using the ACT scores most recently obtained by the students who were or would have been members of the Louisiana 1999 graduating class. Scores are reported for **public schools only** including the laboratory schools and the Louisiana School for Math, Science and the Arts (Natchitoches Parish). The state and national average scores, however, were computed using the scores of both public and nonpublic school students. The first table provides the district, state, and national average composite scores for both 1998 and 1999. The remaining tables provide the 1999 school-level scores.

Summary of ACT Results

Louisiana's average composite score, which included public and nonpublic students, increased from 19.5 in 1998 to 19.6 in 1999 out of a possible 36. The national composite score, which included the 49 other states and the District of Columbia, remained at 21. Overall, Louisiana students gained on the rest of the nation for the second consecutive year, reversing a trend of losing ground every year but one between 1990 and 1997. The state's students improved from 19.4 in 1997 to 19.5 in 1998.

Louisiana's public and nonpublic students combined showed gains in English and mathematics. English scores for Louisiana students increased from 19.5 in 1998 to 19.7 in 1999 while nationally English scores increased from 20.4 in 1998 to 20.5 in 1999. Mathematics scores for Louisiana students also increased from 18.8 in 1998 to 18.9 in 1999. That increase came at a time when mathematics scores nationally declined from 20.8 in 1998 to 20.7 in 1999. Louisiana's scores in reading (19.7) and science reasoning (19.5) remained the same as those in 1998.

Nearly half – or 32 – of Louisiana's 66 public school districts had increased composite scores from 1998. Red River Parish showed the biggest gain of any public school district, increasing from 16.4 in

1998 to 18.3 in 1999, a 1.9-point jump. Assumption Parish had the second-largest gain, increasing from 18.5 in 1998 to 19.6 in 1999, a 1.1-point jump. Twenty-seven districts had decreased average composite scores from 1998, and seven districts maintained the same composite score.

Louisiana was one of five states with the highest proportion of graduates taking the ACT: Mississippi (82 percent), North Dakota (79 percent), Tennessee (77 percent), Louisiana (76 percent), and Kansas (75 percent). In a ranking of composite scores for the fifteen Southern Regional Education Board states, Louisiana's score was ranked twelfth, above those of North Carolina (19.4), South Carolina (19.1), and Mississippi (18.7).

Proportionally, there were more students from poor families taking the test in Louisiana than nationally and fewer from higher income families. In Louisiana, 15 percent of the participants were from families with a family income of less than \$18,000, compared with 9 percent nationally. The ethnic group composition of the Louisiana population of ACT testers was different from that of the nation. While the national population consisted of 72 percent white students, 10 percent African-American/Black students, and a small percentage of other ethnic groups, the Louisiana population contained fewer white students (63%), more African-American/Black students (27%), and very few students from other ethnic groups.
