Introduction

This report contains the average composite, English, mathematics, reading, and science reasoning American College Test (ACT) scores at both the district and school levels. The averages were computed by using the ACT scores most recently obtained by the students who were or would have been members of the Louisiana 2002 graduating class. Scores are reported for **public schools only**, including the laboratory schools, Type 2 charter schools, and the Louisiana School for Mathematics, Science and the Arts (Natchitoches Parish). The state and national average scores, however, were computed using the scores of both public and nonpublic school students. The first table provides the district, state, and national average composite scores for 1998 through 2002. The remaining tables provide the 2002 school-level scores.

Summary of ACT Results

- From 1999 to 2002, the average composite score for Louisiana public and nonpublic students remained at 19.6 out of a possible 36. The national average composite score, which includes the 49 other states and the District of Columbia, has remained 21.0 for the past five years. However, in 2002 it decreased to 20.8 due to a large increase in the number of students taking the ACT nationally, primarily because of a new initiative in both Colorado and Illinois requiring all 11th graders to take the ACT. From 1997 to 1999, Louisiana students gained on the rest of the nation by a tenth of a point each year, increasing from 19.4 to 19.6. With the 2002 decrease in the national average, Louisiana is only 1.2 points below the nation, as compared to 1.4 in previous years.
- Louisiana's public and nonpublic students combined showed a gain in mathematics by increasing from 18.8 in 2001 to 18.9 in 2002. Louisiana's average scores in English (19.7) and reading (19.7) remained the same as those in 2001. The science reasoning score decreased from 19.7 to 19.6.
- Twenty-five of Louisiana's 66 public school districts had increased average composite scores from 2001. Catahoula Parish showed the biggest gain of any public school district, increasing from 18.8 in 2001 to 20.3 in 2002, a 1.5-point jump. West Carroll Parish had the second-largest gain, increasing from 19.5 in 2001 to 20.3 in 2002, a 0.8 jump. Thirty-five districts had decreased average composite scores from 2001, and six districts maintained the same average composite score.
- Louisiana was one of the seven states with a high proportion (greater than 75%) of high school graduates taking the ACT: Colorado (99 percent), Illinois (99 percent), Mississippi (84 percent), Louisiana (79 percent), Tennessee (79 percent), North Dakota (78 percent), and Kansas (76 percent). The percent of Louisiana graduates taking the ACT increased four percentage points, from 76 percent in 1999 to 80 percent in 2001. There was a one percent decrease in 2002. Nationally, 39 percent of graduates took the ACT.
- In a ranking of average ACT composite scores for the sixteen Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) states, Louisiana's average was ranked fourteenth, above the averages of South Carolina (19.2) and Mississippi (18.6). Louisiana's average falls just below Georgia's average of 19.8.
- Proportionally, there were more students from poor families taking the test in Louisiana than nationally, and fewer from higher income families. In Louisiana, 14 percent of the participants were from families with a family income of less than \$18,000, compared with 7 percent nationally.
- The ethnic group composition of the Louisiana population of ACT testers was different from that of the nation. While the national population consisted of 69 percent Caucasian-American/White students, 11 percent African-American/Black students, and a small percentage in each of the other ethnic groups, the Louisiana population contained fewer Caucasian-American/White students (62%), more African-American/Black students (28%), and very few students from other ethnic groups.
