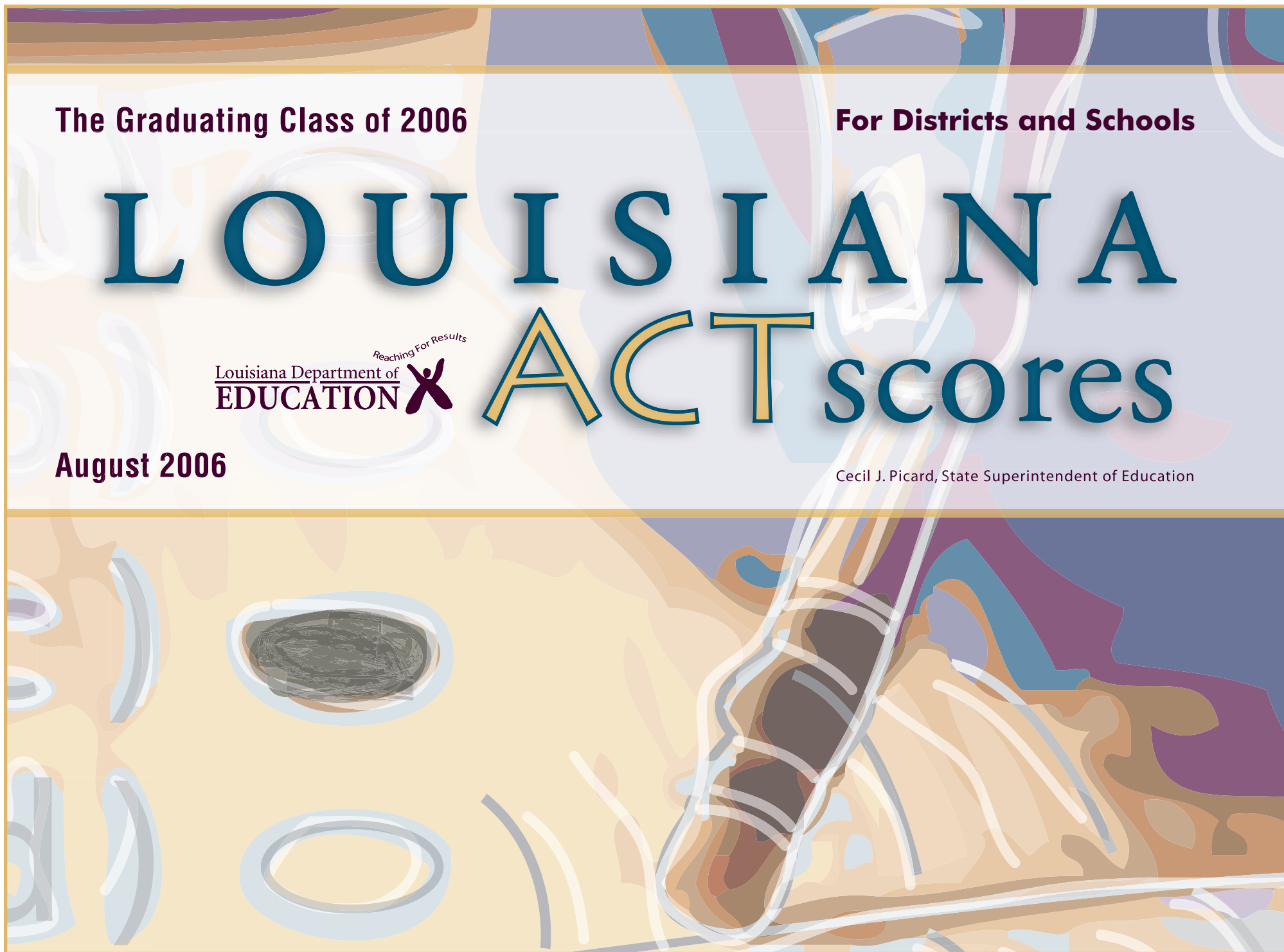

Introduction

This report contains the average composite, English, mathematics, reading, and science American College Test (ACT) scores at both the district and school levels. The averages were computed by using the ACT scores most recently obtained by the students who were or would have been members of the Louisiana 2006 graduating class. Scores are reported for **public schools only**, including the laboratory schools, East Baton Rouge Arts and Technology School, and the Louisiana School for Mathematics, Science and the Arts (Natchitoches Parish). The state and national average scores, however, were computed using the scores of both public and nonpublic school students. The national average composite score includes the 49 other states and the District of Columbia. The first table provides the district, state, and national average composite scores for 2002 through 2006. The remaining tables provide the 2006 school-level scores.

Summary of ACT Results

- The average composite score for Louisiana public and nonpublic students increased to 20.1 in 2006 after remaining at 19.8 for the previous two years.
- The average national ACT composite score rose two-tenths of a point to 21.1 in 2006 after remaining at 20.9 for the previous two years. For 2006, Louisiana is now only 1 point below the nation, as compared to 1.1 points in 2004 and 2005.
- Louisiana's public and nonpublic students combined showed that average scores increased in all areas. English scores increased from 19.9 in 2005 to 20.3 in 2006. Mathematics scores for Louisiana students increased from 19.2 in 2005 to 19.4 in 2006. Reading scores rose from 19.8 in 2005 to 20.1 in 2006. Science scores for Louisiana students increased from 19.7 in 2005 to 19.9 in 2006.
- Forty-three of Louisiana's 68 public school districts had increased average composite scores from 2005. Caldwell Parish showed the biggest gain of any public school district, increasing from 18.0 in 2005 to 19.7 in 2006, a 1.7-point jump. Nineteen districts had decreased average composite scores from 2005, and six districts maintained the same average composite score.
- Louisiana was one of the fifteen states with a high proportion (greater than 70%) of high school graduates taking the ACT, including Colorado (100 percent), Illinois (100 percent), Mississippi (93 percent), Tennessee (93 percent), North Dakota (80 percent), Alabama (79 percent), Kentucky (76 percent), Nebraska (76 percent), Arkansas (75 percent), Kansas (75 percent), South Dakota (75 percent), Louisiana (74 percent), Oklahoma (72 percent), Wyoming (71 percent), and Missouri (70 percent). The percent of Louisiana graduates taking the ACT decreased eleven-percentage points, from 85 percent in 2005 to 74 percent in 2006. Nationally, 40 percent of graduates took the ACT.
- Louisiana ACT test takers in the Class of 2006 decreased this year due to the effects of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, from 35,742 to 33,139.
- In a ranking of average ACT composite scores for the sixteen Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) states, Louisiana's average was ranked fourteenth, above the averages of South Carolina (19.5) and Mississippi (18.8). Louisiana's average falls just below Georgia and Alabama's average of 20.2.
- The ethnic group composition of the Louisiana population of ACT testers contained 20,136 (61%) Caucasian-American/White students, 8,862 (27%) African-American/Black students, and 4,141 (12%) from other ethnic groups.
