Introduction

This report contains the average composite, English, mathematics, reading, and science American College Test (ACT) scores at both the district and school levels. The averages were computed by using the ACT scores most recently obtained by the students who were or would have been members of the Louisiana 2007 graduating class. Scores are reported for **public schools only**, including the laboratory schools, East Baton Rouge Arts and Technology School, and the Louisiana School for Mathematics, Science and the Arts (Natchitoches Parish). The state and national average scores, however, were computed using the scores of both public and nonpublic school students. The national average composite score includes the 49 other states and the District of Columbia. The first table provides the district, state, and national average composite scores for 2003 through 2007. The remaining tables provide the 2007 school-level scores.

Summary of ACT Results

- The average composite score for Louisiana public and nonpublic students remained at 20.1 in 2007. The score increased to 20.1 in 2006 after remaining at 19.8 for the previous two years.
- The average national ACT composite score rose one-tenth of a point to 21.2 in 2007. For 2007, Louisiana is now 1.1 points below the nation, as compared to 1 point in 2006.
- Louisiana's public and nonpublic students combined showed that average scores increased in mathematics and reading and remain the same in English and science. English scores remained the same at 20.3 in 2007. Mathematics scores for Louisiana students increased from 19.4 in 2006 to 19.5 in 2007. Reading scores rose from 20.1 in 2006 to 20.2 in 2007. Science scores for Louisiana students remained the same at 19.9 in 2007.
- Twenty-eight of Louisiana's public school districts had increased average composite scores from 2006. Orleans Parish showed the biggest gain of any public school district, increasing from 17.8 in 2006 to 19.1 in 2007, a 1.3-point jump. Twenty-eight districts had decreased average composite scores from 2006, and twelve districts maintained the same average composite score.
- Louisiana was one of the thirteen states with a high proportion (greater than 75%) of high school graduates taking the ACT, including Colorado (100 percent), Illinois (100 percent), Mississippi (96 percent), Tennessee (96 percent), North Dakota (82 percent), Alabama (81 percent), Louisiana (79 percent), Wyoming (78 percent), Kentucky (77 percent), Nebraska (77 percent), Kansas (76 percent), South Dakota (76 percent), and Arkansas (75 percent). The percent of Louisiana graduates taking the ACT increased five points, from 74 percent in 2006 to 79 percent in 2007. Nationally, 42 percent of graduates took the ACT.
- Louisiana ACT test takers in the Class of 2007 increased this year from 33,139 to 34,042.
- In a ranking of average ACT composite scores for the sixteen Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) states, Louisiana's average was ranked thirteenth, above the averages of Florida (19.9), South Carolina (19.6) and Mississippi (18.9). Louisiana's average falls just below Georgia and Alabama's average of 20.3.
- The ethnic group composition of the Louisiana population of ACT testers contained 19,786 (58%) Caucasian-American/White students, 9,229 (27%) African-American/Black students, and 5,027 (15%) from other ethnic groups.
