Description of Credentials	The CIW Advanced HTML5 and CSS3 Specialist is the first course in the CIW Web and mobile Design series. This course tests essential HTML5, Cascading Style Sheets (CSS) and JavaScript knowledge. These technologies, known as the Web development trifecta, provide Web pages that easily adapt to smartphones, tablets, gaming devices and smart TVs, as well as to traditional PCs. This course teaches deep knowledge of HTML5 and CSS3, and thus assumes a certain amount of existing knowledge (such as basic HTML coding). The target audience is students, web designers, internet consultants, IT professionals, marketing professionals, web and graphic artists, and business professionals.

Instructor Certification Requirements (by certifying agency)	Advanced HTML5 and CSS3 Specialist teacher certification is required. Proctoring / Test Security (if any)	CIW exams are administered under secure, proctored conditions at Authorized Prometric and Pearson VUE testing centers. Prometric and Pearson VUE confirm the identity of exam candidates, and provide a controlled environment for collecting and transmitting exam results.

Certification Tracking

Credentialing Documentation	CIW maintains all documentation. Students create their own account in the CIW Candidate Information Center and can track Advanced HTML5 and CSS3 Specialist certification (and other certifications offered by CIW) online. Students can print out copies of their certifications they have earned or have the certificate mailed to them. <i>Teachers can track the certification results of their students using the student voucher number used for the exam. Schools will not be able to track the results of students who take the exam at a public testing center without the cooperation /disclosure by the student.</i>
