The exam must be proctored by a school instructor/ administrator and must be closed book/closed notes. Any student enrolled in the school and taking the curriculum may take the exam. Accommodations may be made for students with learning or physical disabilities as long as the exam is proctored as listed above. * Performance test is not a requirement of the certification, but the CGA guidebook does provide a checklist for trainer observation as student demonstrate the tasks to meet property standards.
