

FY2011-12 Weighted Student Funding Gifted and Talented Students

Revised Statute 17:7(2)(f)(i) requires Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) to expend funds by applying the weighted factors contained in the formula for Gifted and Talented students on items that serve the unique needs of the students who generate such funds. The calculated expenditure of these weighted funds must be reported in each LEA's Annual Financial Report (AFR).
