

HOW ARE SCHOOLS HELD ACCOUNTABLE FOR STUDENTS TAKING LAA 1 AND LAA 2?

Starting with the 2012-2013 school year, the Louisiana Department of Education has improved the way schools are graded by aligning with higher standards, rewarding the gains schools have already made, and focusing on students below grade level. As part of this transition, Louisiana changed the achievement levels for students taking alternative assessments, LAA 1 and LAA 2, using the following point allocation. *Please note that LAA 2 does not apply to high schools.*
