ACT: Raising Expectations for Students

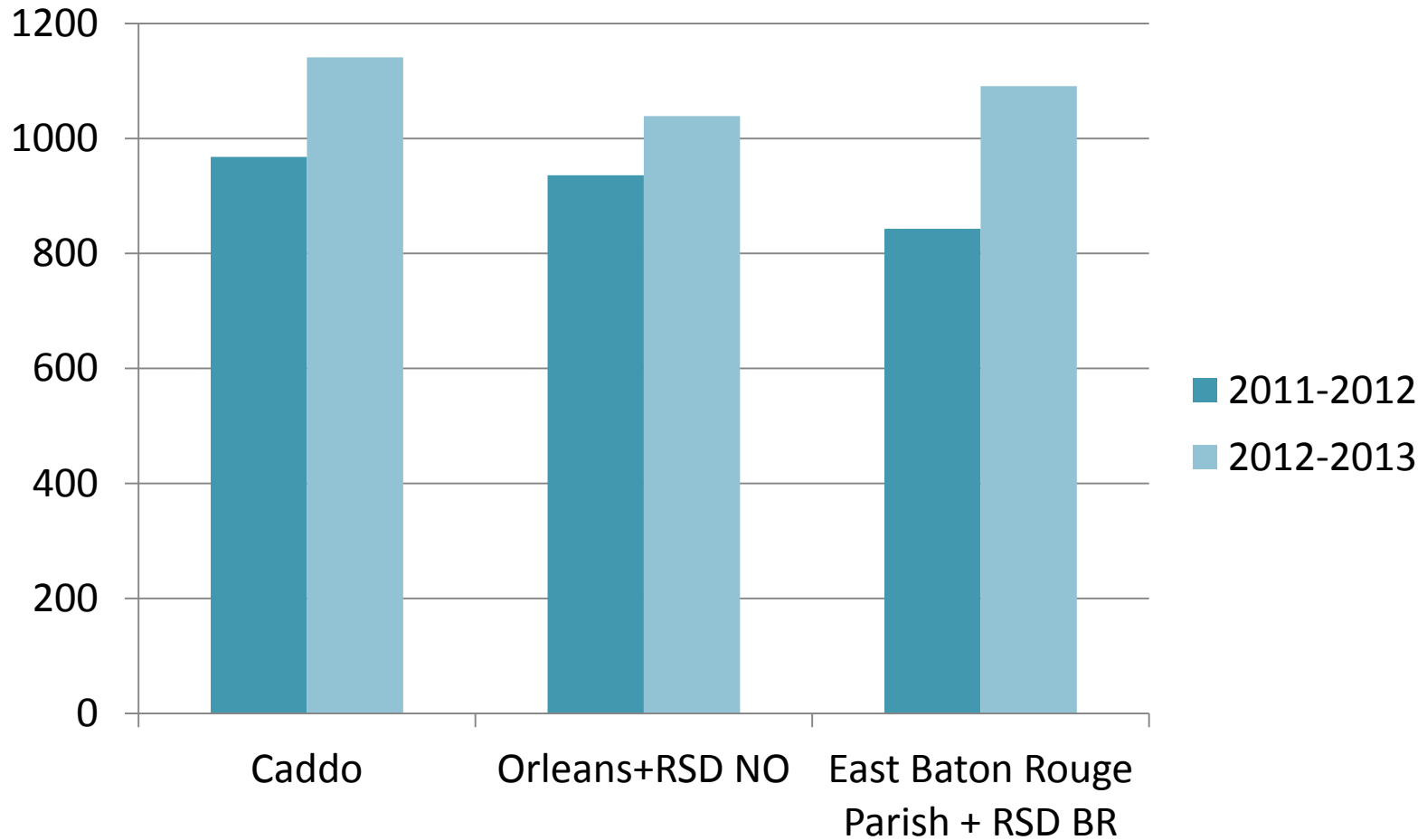
Louisiana became the 10th state in the country to test all high school students on the ACT series of tests. These tests

- Prepare our students for new rigorous standards;
 - Ensure greater college and technical training access for our disadvantaged students;
 - Provide schools with year-over-year college- and career-readiness information

- As a result, nearly 3,600 more Louisiana seniors are eligible to attend college or technical training programs next year.
 - This represents a 20 percent increase in graduates with this opportunity over 2012.

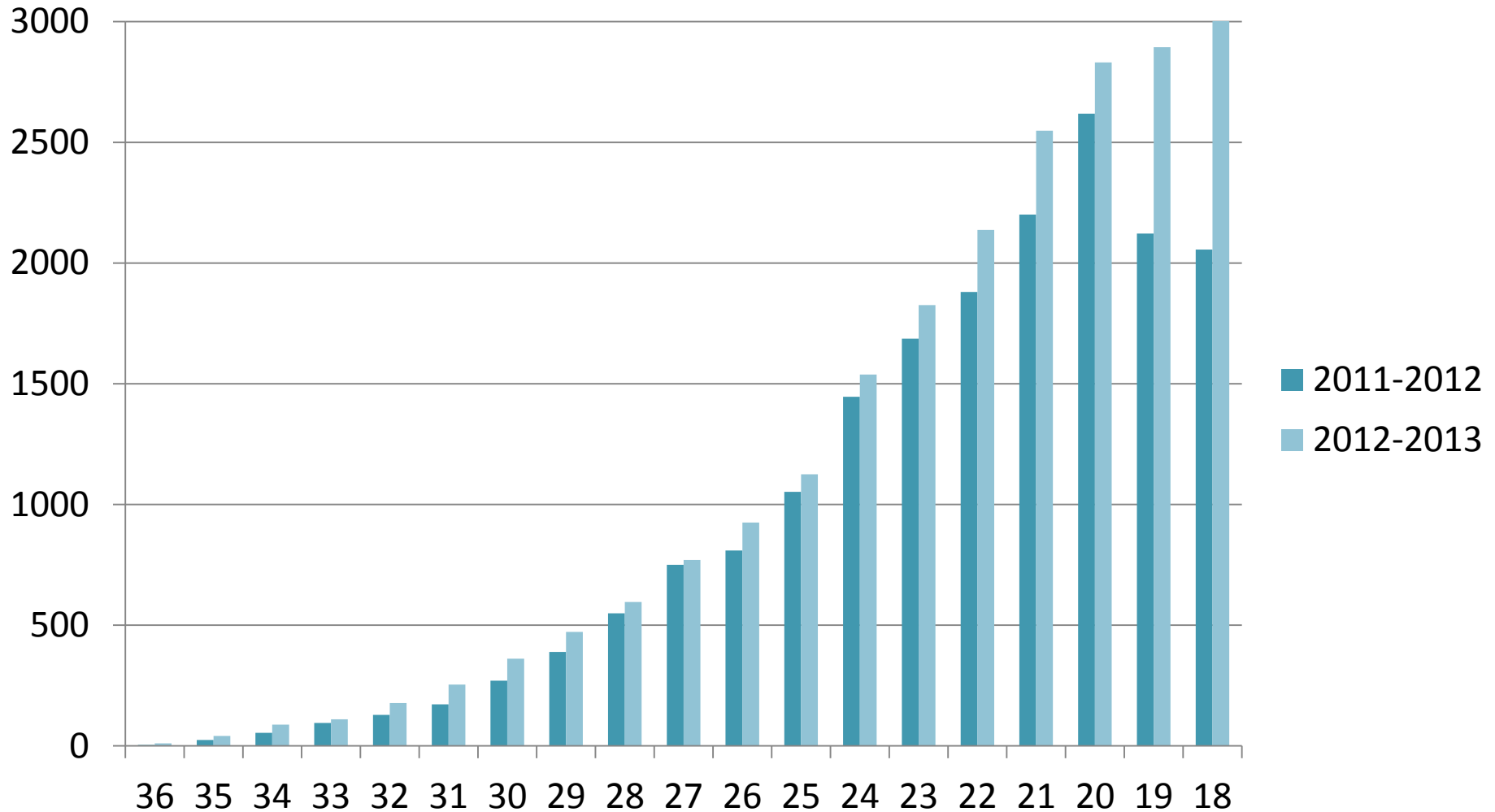

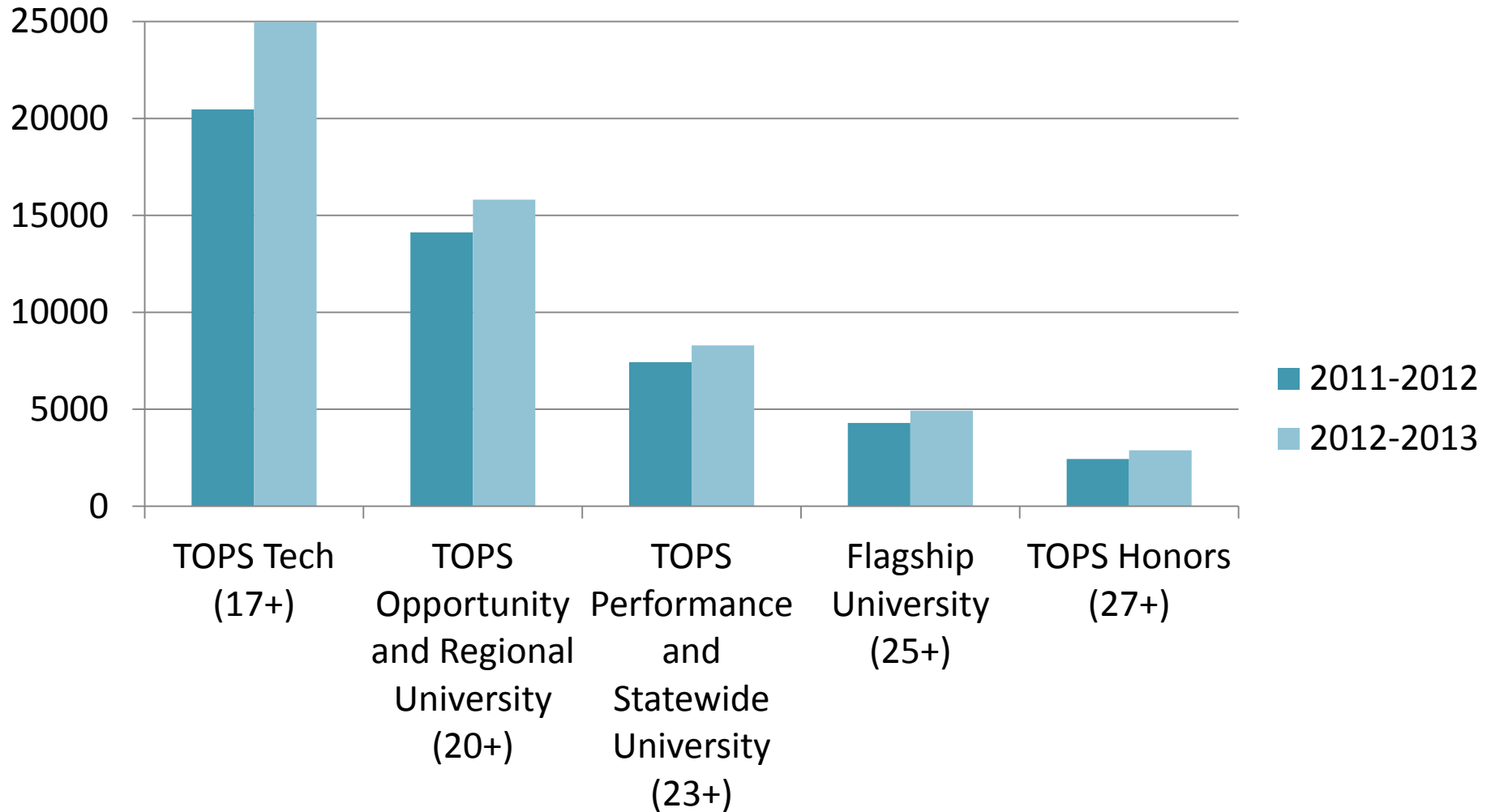
Urban Districts Increase Number of Students with a College-going Score
