

World Languages Carnegie Credit

Louisiana students may earn Carnegie credit for a World Language (WL) Course by demonstrating a minimum proficiency in the target language that corresponds to <u>Louisiana World Language Standards</u>. Students must demonstrate on-level proficiency in at least four of the five domains: Interpersonal, Interpretive Listening, Interpretive Reading, Presentational Speaking, and Presentational Writing (Bulletin741 page 50).

School systems can award Carnegie credit using one of the following proficiency based assessment tools:

- 1. a nationally recognized examination (See guidance below.),
- 2. a locally developed examination documented by the Department (Review and feedback is ongoing.), or
- 3. a portfolio submission, e.g., LinguaFolio

To assist school systems in determining appropriate academic placement and/or awarding Carnegie credit, the Department has aligned **nationally recognized** proficiency-based assessments (the <u>AAPPL</u>, the <u>STAMP 4S</u>, and <u>WorldSpeak</u>) and non-proficiency-based (the <u>Advanced Placement</u> and <u>CLEP</u>) assessments to Louisiana WL Standards. Other nationally recognized proficiency-based assessments may be aligned to Louisiana WL Standards by the Department upon request. For questions contact <u>Language.Acquisition@la.gov</u>.
