Who can be identified to help remove the identified barriers? Review Step 6 of the Dual Language Immersion (DLI) Program Planning Document. Internalize and Practice	 Share Out Protocol: Over the next 2-4 meetings and asynchronously, will work collaboratively to identify and resolve potential barriers to DLI program implementation. Team members will continue to refine program norms and components. ILT will develop a timeline of meetings and asynchronous check-ins and anticipated outcomes for each segment of the developed timeline. Steps outlined in this and previous agendas should be replicated using enough time to adequately address identified barriers and refine program structures to achieve a publishable document. 		
Next Steps	Using Step 6 <i>of the</i> <u>Dual Language Immersion (DLI) Program Planning Document</u> and the <u>The</u> <u>Louisiana Guide to Effective Dual Language Immersion Programming</u> as guides, team members will work through ILT meetings and asynchronously to finalize a publishable DLI program document.
