**Student Requirements for the Seal of Biliteracy**

To earn the Seal of Biliteracy, students must

- fulfill all required English Language Arts coursework,
- achieve a composite score of 19 or above on the Reading/English components of the ACT,
- pass the ELPT with an Early Advanced Proficiency (ELs only), and
- satisfy at least one (1) of the following criteria:
  - achieve the B2 DELF or DELE,
  - earn an Intermediate-High on a national proficiency exam, e.g., AAPPL, STAMP, etc.,
  - pass 4 years of World Language high school levels I-IV courses, or
  - score a 4+ on a World Language AP or IB exam.
