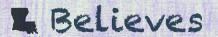
ESSER III 20% Evidenced-Based Activities

As per ED, LEAs must reserve at least 20 percent of funds to address learning loss through the implementation of evidence-based interventions.

School systems must ensure that the interventions

- respond to students' social, emotional, and academic needs
- address the disproportionate impact of COVID-19 on underrepresented student subgroups
 - o each major racial and ethnic group
 - o children from low-income families
 - children with disabilities
 - English learners
 - gender
 - migrant students
 - students experiencing homelessness
 - o children and youth in foster care

The Department is developing additional guidance around evidence-based interventions to support school systems. This information will be shared via the newsletter and Pandemic Relief Library.



ESSER III Update - Achieve! Guidance

An LEA that receives ARP ESSER funds must, within 30 days of receiving the funds, make publicly available on its website a plan for safe return to in-person instruction and continuity of services. School systems can meet this requirement by seeking public comment and updating the school reopening plans submitted to LDOE in the fall of 2020. In light of the Governor's Roadmap to Restarting Louisiana, the Department has issued guidance pertaining to opening public and nonpublic school facilities to serve students in the 2020-2021 school year. This guidance is relative to operating schools in Phases 1, 2 and 3 of reopening. Since Louisiana's school facilities first closed in March 2020 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, school systems and the Department have worked to ensure the safety of students and staff was of utmost priority. The Louisiana Department of Education compiled links to existing system and school reopening plans. Please ensure your system has received public comment within 30 days of receiving funds and an updated plan is published to the school system website. View the original plans submitted to LDOE.



Reporting



ESSER I, II, and III funds must be tracked separately for reporting and budgeting purposes. For ESSER II and III, LDOE will use specific funding codes to track school system expenses by the <u>allowability</u> and by <u>priority and focus areas</u>.

To provide transparency around these funds, the Department will create a dashboard that reports the amounts budgeted and expended by LEA on a monthly/ quarterly basis. Additionally, LDOE will track state set-aside funds in the same manner, and provide quarterly updates on these expenses. This reporting will begin this summer.





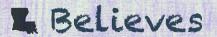
Priorities-aligned Initiatives and Planning Resources

Achieve! Planning Guidance

The Department developed <u>Achieve!</u> planning guidance to support school systems as they begin planning for the development of <u>Achieve!</u> budgets using ESSER II and ESSER III formula funds. There are new, updated, and previously released high-impact initiatives aligned to each priority and corresponding focus areas.

In planning, school systems will:

- Commit to priorities within the <u>Believe to Achieve Educational Priorities</u> and initiatives
- Identify stakeholders to be a part of the *Achieve!* planning team
- Use three key resources while planning: <u>ESSER II and ESSER III Allowabilities</u>, *Achieve!* Planning Guidance, and EIC codes



Staffing and Scheduling

The <u>Staffing and Scheduling Best Practices Guidance</u> and kick-off webinar were released last month. This guidance provides systems and school leaders:

- best practices,
- staffing and scheduling models,
- cautions and tips for implementation,
- and information on ongoing implementation support available.

Staffing and Scheduling

School Support Institutes

In alignment with Louisiana's <u>Educational Priorities</u>, the School Support Institutes (SSI) are designed to support leadership teams by:

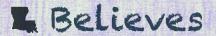
- providing the highest quality teaching and learning environment, and
- developing and retaining a diverse, highly effective educator workforce.

Three full-day trainings and three follow-up support sessions will be aligned to these pathways: Observation and Feedback, ILT Support, Common Planning, Zone Schools, and Literacy (UIN only).

Schools identified as CIR and UIR-A schools and those Identified UIN schools participating in the CLSD UIN grant are required to participate. Required participation will be funded by the Department in accordance with the details found on the <u>overview document.</u>

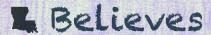

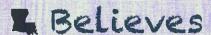
NEW Pandemic Relief Access



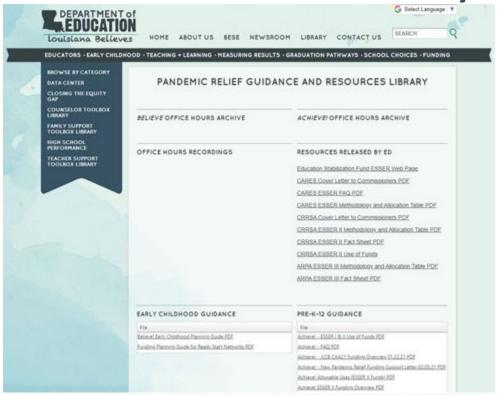


NEW Pandemic Relief Landing Page

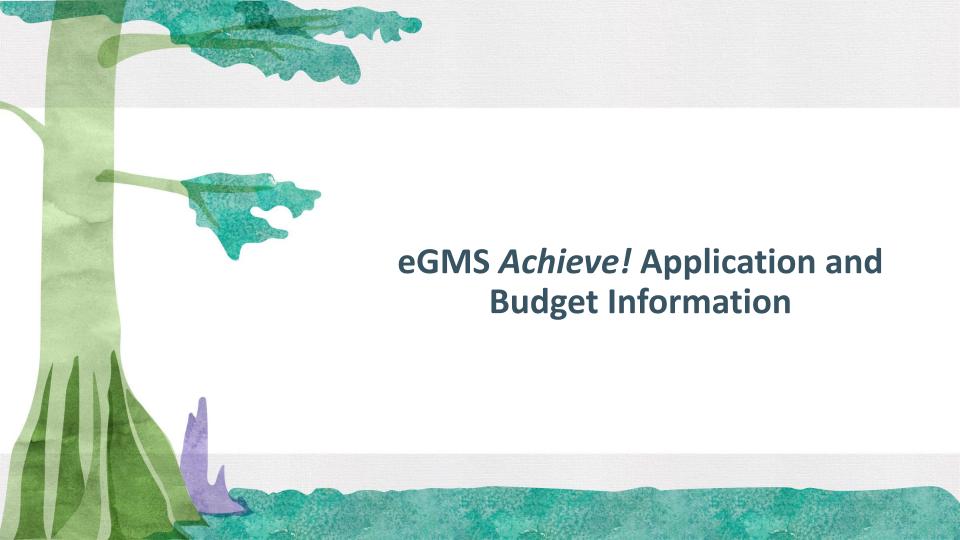

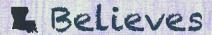

To support school systems in using this money in a strategic, priorities-based manner, LDOE will release a guidance document with evidenced-based best practices.

Timeline	Action
March, 2021	Release 50% of ESSER II and 20% of ESSER III EB formula allocations to LEAs with guidance
April, 2021	LEAs use the guidance and assess needs to build out budgets in Achieve!
May 3, 2021	Achieve! budget applications are due in eGMS.
May, 2021	LDOE reviews Achieve! budgets
June 1, 2021	UPDATE: Initial reviews and feedback provided on all Achieve! budgets by June 1.
