Kindergarten Entry Assessment (District selected; LDOE approved)	Children enrolled in Kindergarten for the first time	Evaluates kindergarten readiness of individual children to identify where a child may need additional instructional supports.	Teachers share results with parents directly.
K-3 Literacy Screening Assessment (District selected; LDOE approved)	Children in Grades K-3	Identifies which children may be at risk for experiencing reading difficulties so they can receive timely and effective support.	Teachers share results with parents directly.
English Language Proficiency Test (ELPT)	Students who are learning English as a second language are assessed annually using the ELPT.	The ELPT assessment measures proficiency in listening, speaking, reading, and writing.	Teachers share results with parents directly.
