2021 OVERALL TEACHER OF THE YEAR



Mathalie Roy East Baton Rouge Parish Twitter: @MagistraRoy Nathalie Roy teaches Roman technology, classical mythology, and Latin at Glasgow Middle School in East Baton Rouge Parish. Her classes feature interactive lessons about the ancient Romans and Greeks infused with STEM, a unique curricular idea that has afforded her many grant opportunities. Roy is a graduate of public school in Avoyelles Parish where both her parents were teachers. Roy studied classical archaeology at the American Academy in Rome (as a Fulbright Scholar) and at the American School of Classical Studies at Athens. A National Board Certified Teacher, Roy has published articles on Roman technology with Cambridge University Press and the American Classical League, with whom she has partnered during the pandemic to offer free, live-stream, hands-on lessons on Roman technology. Although most of Roy's students had never been exposed to classical mythology, under her instruction 63% of students at Approaching Basic or Basic rose to 89% at Mastery or Advanced. Additionally, her Latin students went from 60% at Approaching or Basic to 100% Mastery or Advanced. Dedicated to service and citizenship, Roy is a longtime volunteer with Girl Scouts Louisiana East where she leads two troops. As a life-long Girl Scout, she strives through teaching to be a person of courage, confidence, and character who makes the world a better place.

She is the proud daughter of two Louisiana educators who share a combined total of 65+ years of teaching experience. Her parents instilled in each of their five children the importance of faith, love, and education. Bradford began as the assistant principal of Parkway in 2016, and was appointed principal in 2017. Parkway is located near an Army installation in Fort Polk, LA. The school houses 580 students in Grades 1-4, and is over 90% military affiliated. On average, Parkway tends to gain or lose five-seven students monthly due to military deployments or station reassignments. Despite the challenges of a transient population, Bradford remains resilient and ensures that notable learning impact is made for all students. Under her leadership, Parkway was recognized as an A" school in 2017. Parkway was recognized last year as a Louisiana "Top Gains" school with 10.1 growth points and was also honored for receiving the most growth in the district with an SPS increase of 9.6 points. Previously, Bradford taught 3rd grade at West Leesville Elementary for 15 years. She received her Bachelor's degree in Elementary Education from Southern University A&M College and her masters in Educational Leadership from McNeese State University.
