

The College Board has released [updated guidance](#) for schools impacted by Coronavirus.

Exam Updates:

- Traditional face-to-face exams will **NOT** take place for the Spring of 2020.
- For the 2019-2020 AP exam administration, students will complete an online exam lasting 45 minutes at home on two separate dates (**dates TBA April 3**).
- All exams will be Free Response Questions (FRQ) only. No multiple choice questions will be featured on this exam.
- The College Board will release more information regarding the specifics of each AP exam on **April 3**.

 - AP Research (academic paper only)
 - AP Seminar
