

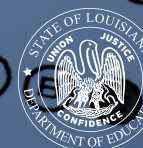

Introduction

This report contains the average composite, English, mathematics, reading, and science ACT scores at both the district and school levels. The averages were computed by using the ACT scores most recently obtained by the students who were or would have been members of the Louisiana 2010 graduating class. Scores are reported for **public schools only**, including the laboratory schools and the Louisiana School for Mathematics, Science and the Arts (Natchitoches Parish). The state and national average scores, however, were computed using the scores of both public and nonpublic school students. The national average composite score includes the 49 other states and the District of Columbia. The first table provides the district, state, and national average composite scores for 2006 through 2010. The remaining tables provide the 2010 school-level scores.

Summary of ACT Results

- The average ACT composite score for Louisiana public and nonpublic students remained unchanged: 20.1 in 2010. Since 2005, Louisiana's composite score has increased by three-tenths of a point, from 19.8 in 2005 to 20.1 in 2010.
- After two consecutive years, the national ACT composite decreased from 21.1 in 2008 and 2009 to 21.0 in 2010.
- Louisiana's public and nonpublic students combined showed an increase in the average score in science, while the average scores in math and reading remained the same as in 2009. The 2010 average score in English decreased two-tenths of a point from 2009 to 2010.
- Twenty-nine of Louisiana's public school districts had increased average composite scores from 2009. Thirty-nine districts had decreased average composite scores from 2009, and two districts maintained the same average composite score.
- Districts with the highest ACT composite averages were West Feliciana (21.9) and St. Tammany (21.8). Districts showing the biggest gain in their 2010 composite scores were St. Helena (1.4 point gain), Bienville (1.2 point gain), and Plaquemines (1.1 point gain).
- Louisiana was one of eight states with a high proportion of high school graduates taking the ACT. These states are Colorado (100 percent), Illinois (100 percent), Kentucky (100 percent), Michigan (100 percent), Tennessee (100 percent), Wyoming (100 percent), Louisiana (98 percent), and Mississippi (96 percent). The percent of Louisiana graduates taking the ACT increased nine points, from 89 percent in 2009 to 98 percent in 2010. Nationally, 47 percent of graduates took the ACT.
- The ethnic group composition of the Louisiana population of ACT testers contained 20,522 (58%) Caucasian-American/White students, 11,389 (32%) African-American/Black students, and 3,690 (10%) from other ethnic groups.
- In a ranking of ACT composite scores for the sixteen Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) states, Louisiana's average was ranked eleventh, above the averages of South Carolina (20.0), Tennessee (19.6), Florida (19.5), Kentucky (19.4), and Mississippi (18.8). Louisiana's average falls below Arkansas (20.3) and Alabama (20.3).
- Louisiana's national rank is 41, based on the 2010 ACT Results.
