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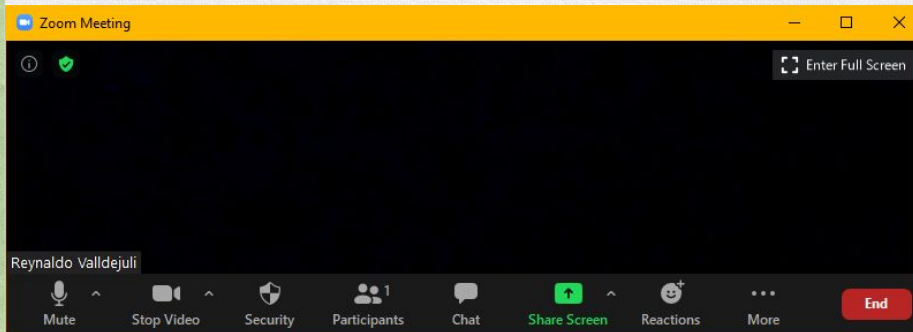

# Stronger Connections Grant Program

- The Stronger Communities Grant (SCG) seeks to provide funding to school systems on a competitive basis to support school safety efforts.
- LDOE has designed a **competitive** sub-grant competition.
- Subgrants will go to “high-need” local educational agencies (LEAs) as determined by LDOE.
- Supplement not supplant and equitable services will apply to this grant.

Louisiana’s Award - \$21,279,385 (one time funds)

Funds Expire - 9/30/2025

- Title IV allocations may be used to supplement on - going strategies and programs.
