Introduction

Acadience Reading Screeners identify which students may be at risk for experiencing reading difficulties so that teachers can provide timely and effective support. Real-time Access to Early Literacy will use Acadience Reading (formerly DIBELS Next) progress monitoring tools as pre/post-assessments during each tutoring cycle.

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Administration

Acadience Reading Screeners must be administered during the first week of a student attending literacy tutoring. The screener should also be administered during the last week of each tutoring cycle. Pre- and post-assessment data should be entered into the pre/post-assessment form and provided to the REAL program manager during the first and last week of each tutoring cycle. Reporting Results

Tutoring Service Providers should upload pre/post literacy screeners to LDOE for each tutoring cycle. Pre-assessment data should be shared with LDOE by the end of the third week of the tutoring cycle. Post-assessment data should be shared with the LDOE no later than two weeks after the end of the tutoring cycle.
