Type III Centers: Stay Connected with Your Network	Congratulations! You're a licensed Type III center. You've made a commitment to provide the children in your center with high quality learning. Stay up-to-date with the requirements of Type III centers. <u>Sign up</u> for <i>Early</i> <i>Childhood Connection</i> , the Department of Education's newsletter with an active email address. Participate in <u>lead agency</u> meetings and sign up to receive information about local activities.
Public Information for Families: Receive a Rating	As a Type III center you will receive a performance profile that provides families information on your center. This video explains how scores are put into a performance profile. Each center has a webpage on Louisiana School and Center Finder where this information is available for families.
Prepared Teachers: Ensure Teachers Have an Ancillary Certificate	 Beginning July 1, 2019, Lead teachers must have an Early Childhood Ancillary Certificate within 24 months of their start date as a lead teacher. What is the certificate and how do I earn one? Learn more about scholarships for this certificate. A teacher's level of education is linked to tax credits. View the Early Childhood Ancillary Certificate (ECAC) Staff Map.
High-Quality Interactions with Children: Achieve Excellence	 Each year, Type III classrooms are observed for quality interactions between teachers and children. Scores are made publicly available and connected to tax credits for directors. The Effective Teacher-Child Interactions video explains the CLASS tool that is used to measure these interactions. Your Resource and Referral agency can provide CLASS training and other professional development.
Standards & Curriculum: Use the Right Tools	Choose a <u>Tier I curriculum to provide children with a high-quality educational</u> experience based on Louisiana's Early Learning & Development Standards. Your Resource and Referral agency has a library of <u>Tier I curriculum</u> you can review. The <u>Curriculum Initiative</u> will support Type III centers in purchasing curriculum by reimbursing up to 80% of the cost.
Assessing and Observing Children: Track Child Growth	Record assessment information on every publicly-funded child using GOLD® by TeachingStrategies. This document provides an overview for how GOLD® is used in early childhood classrooms.
