There are several sources professional development for early learning centers in Louisiana that can be used towards the continuing education requirements included in <u>Bulletin 137</u> (*Louisiana Early Learning Center Licensing Regulations*).

Coaching provided through the CCR&R or Mental Health Consultation Program	This may include in-person coaching provided by coaches and technical assistants employed by Louisiana's <u>Child Care Resource and Referral Centers</u> (CCR&R) or <u>Mental Health Consultation Program</u> .
Pediatric first aid training and infant/child/adult CPR training	This may be used towards continuing education requirements in the anniversary year in which it is taken.
Medication administration training by a child care health consultant	This may be used towards continuing education requirements in the anniversary year in which it is taken, and must be provided by an approved <u>child care health consultant</u> that has been approved by the <u>Louisiana</u> <u>Department of Health</u> .

The three hours of annual training by a child care health consultant on infectious diseases, health and safety, and/or food-service preparation required in do not count towards continuing education hours for staff members.

Please note that certificates are required for all training and must include the date, course topic, and the total number of hours of the course.
