Re: NOTICE - LEVEL 2 - Tropical Storm Sally

The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) would like to inform you of a potential threat to Louisiana from the impending Tropical Storm which is expected to produce heavy rain, hail, tornadoes, and potential flooding. The LDOE will closely monitor conditions out of concern for your safety and for the safety of the children and families you serve.

If you are a child care provider, please take the following steps to prepare:

- Print the appropriate Reopen Request form to have on hand.
  - o For Early Learning Centers Licensing
  - For Family Day Care Homes and In-Home Providers CCAP

NOTE: If you are a Type III Center and serve CCAP children, you only need to complete the Reopening form for the Early Learning Centers – Licensing.

- Stay up-to-date with the status of the potential flooding and its impact on your area.
- Review and update evacuation and safety plans.
- Practice evacuation and reunification plans.
- Let families know how you will communicate if you are unable to reopen following a disaster.
- Review the FAQs below and be ready if a disaster declaration is made for your parish:

  - o Reinstatement of a Child Care Center License Following a Disaster
