

## TOPS University Louisiana Transfer Degree Associate of Arts: Concentration in Business \*Postsecondary: Nunez Community College\*

## Overview

The Louisiana Transfer Degree Program is designed to provide students with an opportunity to complete the first 60 hours of coursework toward a baccalaureate degree at a 2-year or community college. Graduates are eligible to enter a 4-year Louisiana public university as a junior, with all 60 (non-developmental) credits transferring to the receiving university. The Transfer Degree Guarantee refers to a guaranteed and easy transfer for students from a 2-year community college to a public university in Louisiana. Students will gain knowledge of the American business environment. Students on this framework will earn the Certified Internet Web (CIW) credentials which covers the foundational standards and job skills to master a technology-driven world that enables the Internet to function, including web design, development, administration, networking, databases, and security
