Well designed and properly equipped program



Age-appropriate activities



Academic, psychological, and physical needs are met



Connection to the school day



Long-term positive outcomes

New York State Network for Youth Success

- A quality program is one that is reflective and willing to improve, change, and grow.
- 2 It believes in successful outcomes for its participants.
- It understands that improving program quality is an ongoing process.

LAPQI Tool Kit



A "tool" that it is meant to help your organization grow over time and designed to be tailored according to your needs.

It is not meant to be used as a device for judging the program as "good" or "bad."

The tool kit is intended to be used as a guide for reflecting on your program and making every part of it the best that it can be.

Self-Assessment



Opportunities to identify strengths and weaknesses free from the pressures of external monitoring and evaluation.

Organizations that have linked the self-assessment process to decision-making report they meet their goals and achieve success.

Commitment to Quality



Provides 21st CCLC programs with a clear and concise way to assess their program quality

Facilitates program improvement and support through an internal staff-directed process

Organized into five quality elements identified through review of afterschool literature and research:

- 1. Environment (Indoor and Outdoor)
- 2. Relationships and Connections
- 3. Programming
- 4. Youth Participation and Engagement
- 5. Emergency Preparedness

Quality Indicators

Under each standard, you'll find a quality indicator, a list of characteristics describing an evidence based practice.

At each level, you'll find examples that describe what that level of mastery might look like in a real program.

These examples are there to help take the guesswork out of the self-assessment process.

Commitment to Quality



At each indicator, you should ask yourself,

"Is my program most like a 1, 2, 3, or 4?"

- Excellent exceeds standard
- Good meets standard
- 2. Some Progress Made approaching standard
- 1. Must Address and Improve not meeting standard

This rating system will help you see where your program excels, and where it needs some work.

Uncovering patterns or trends will aid you in the improvement process.

Set SMART goals to support program quality improvement.
