Early College Admission Policy Guidance

§2329. Early College Admissions

The Early College Admissions policy is in place for those students who want to be admitted to a college on a full-time basis prior to graduation. To qualify for early admission a student must meet the following requirements:

- Maintained a "B" or better average on wall work pursued during three years (six semesters) of high school
- Earned a minimum composite score of 25 on the ACT or an equivalent SAT score, the score must be submitted to the college

School systems with students eligible for Early College Admission should submit the following information to LDOE.

- A letter on school letterhead signed by the Principal (electronic signature is acceptable) with the following information:
 - LA SID is eligible for a high school diploma pursuant to BESE policy, Bulletin 741 §2329. Early College Admissions Policy. This student has completed 24 semester hours of college credit at ______ name of college/university. Attached you will find a transcript from the college registrar certifying the hours earned and the transcript of high school credits earned at _____ name of school, school system.
