OVERVIEW

The Human Services Jump Start 2.0 Pathway focuses on careers in early childhood development and services that nurture and teach children in the pre-kindergarten setting. Pathway coursework equips students to help individuals and families meet their personal needs while working in childcare centers, nursery schools, preschools, public schools, private households, family childcare homes, and before and after school programs. This pathway is also for students interested in careers providing professional services to children and adults. These careers include cosmetologists, barbers, hairstylists, clothing tailors, estheticians, and spa attendants.

Finding high-wage career opportunities directly out of high school can be challenging. It typically requires advanced capstone credentials accompanied by work experience and/or apprenticeships in the field.
