OVERVIEW

The Law, Public Safety, Corrections and Security Jump Start 2.0 Pathway includes instruction in criminal justice and corrections, fire protection, homeland security, and other protective services. Students will be exposed to the theories and principles of correctional science; criminal law and policy; police and correctional systems organization; the administration of justice and the judiciary; and emergency and fire management services. Law, Public Safety, Corrections, and Security workers focus on protecting citizens in a vast array of settings. These settings include state and federal agencies as well as public and private entities.
