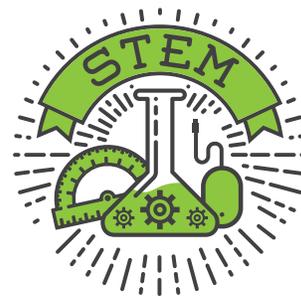


# STEM PATHWAY BRIEF

Students who successfully complete four of the required courses will earn a Silver STEM Diploma Seal.
