Description of Credentials	Based on the hands-on "lab standards" of the American Welding Society http://www.aws.org/ ABC-Pelican has distilled the AWS modules most important to Louisiana employers into two levels of hands-on welding instruction. Level 1 covers the eight most important topics / hands-on welding skills. Level 2 covers five more advanced hands-on welding skills. Students must have their hands-on welding skills tested and confirmed by an approved testing company (see below). These testing companies evaluate each student's welds according to American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) standards. Passing students are provided an AWS credential. Employers routinely re-test all certified new employees to confirm their welding skills.
