LCTCS

- Open Access Institutions
 - No minimum test score
- Online application
 - No application fee
- Immunization (waiver)
- Selective Service (male)

Our Louisiana 2020

- DOUBLE Graduates to 40,000 Annually
- DOUBLE the Annual Earnings of Our Graduates to \$1.5 Billion
- QUADRUPLE Student Transfers to Four-Year Universities to 10,000 Annually
- DOUBLE the Number of Students Served to 325,000 Annually
- QUADRUPLE Partnerships with Business and Industry to 1,000 Annually
- DOUBLE Foundation Assets to \$50 Million

FFA Community College Scholarship

- As a Louisiana graduate students are eligible for a one time 500 scholarship to any LCTCS college.
- Louisiana FFA LDE and CDE Champions are eligible for an additional 1,000 scholarship. (contact chapter advisors for details)
- June 1 application deadline for summer enrollment.
- August 1 application deadline for fall
- Must be enrolled full time
- Simply apply to the college to qualify.



JAG Community College Scholarship

- As a Louisiana graduate students are eligible for a one time 500 scholarship to any LCTCS college.
- Award is available for Summer or Fall
- June 1 application deadline for summer enrollment.
- August 1 application deadline for fall
- Must be enrolled full time
- Simply apply to the college to qualify



Skills USA Community College Scholarship

- As a Louisiana graduate students are eligible for a one time 500 scholarship to any LCTCS college.
- State gold medalist are eligible for an additional 1,000 scholarship. (contact key advisors for details)
- Award may be used Summer or Fall
- June 1 application deadline for summer enrollment.
- August 1 application deadline for fall
- Must be enrolled full time
- Simply apply to the college to qualify



Jump Start Construction Connect Scholars Program

- Any high school senior who will earn a Jump Start NCCER credential
- Louisiana high school Jump Start diploma
- Enrolls as a fulltime student in an LCTCS Construction Pathway Program or an Associated Builders and Contractors training program in the summer or fall semester immediately following their high school graduation
- Recipients of this scholarship will be selected by the LCEF Board based on the strength of the industry credential they earned in high school, letters of recommendation, participation in Career and Technical Student Organizations, and academic achievements such as GPA, course work, and skills competition recognition
- One time maximum award of 1,000 per student

TOPS Tech

- Eligibility Requirements

Minimum High School GPA of 2.50 (GPA computed on core courses only)

21 units that comprise the TOPS Tech JumpStart Core Curriculum

Students may also qualify for the TOPS Tech Award by completing the TOPS Core Curriculum for the Opportunity, Performance and Honors Awards

Minimum ACT Score ([or SAT Equivalent](#)) of 17

Must enroll full time as a first time freshman, by the first semester following the first anniversary of high school graduation

Be a US citizen or permanent resident

Meet TOPS Louisiana Residency requirements

- ANGUS Process Technology Scholarship
- Applicants must be in a business major pursuing an Associate Degree at the West Monroe Campus. The scholarship is available to new and continuing students. Applicants must submit an LDCC application, 2-page essay and 2 references.
- Bankers Scholarship
- Homeland, Caldwell and Citizens banks created a scholarship opportunity for students that attend campuses in our rural communities, who receive financial aid (Pell), but their aid falls short of covering their expenses (i.e. textbooks, tuition and fees and for other required class materials and equipment). Each applicant must have and maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Applicants must submit an LDCC application, 2-page essay and 2 references.
- Black Male Initiative Scholarship
- Applicants must be a B2MP member that is actively participating in the program, earned at least 30 hours and be enrolled in a minimum of 6 hours per semester. Each applicant must have and maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Applicants must submit an LDCC application, 3-page, double-spaced essay (topic will be selected by LDCC faculty mentors) and 2 references.

Fletcher Technical Community College

- **Claude Daspit LPN Scholarship Fund:** Applicants selected for this scholarship must be pursuing the following degree option: Officially accepted into Practical Nursing. Requirements: 2.5 GPA, Full time or part time student
- **The Broadway Elder Living and Rehabilitation Scholarship:** Applicants selected for this scholarship must be pursuing the following degree options: Nursing, Nursing Assistant, and Practical Nursing. Requirements: 2.5 GPA, Full time student.
- **Follett Scholarships:** Applicants selected for this scholarship must be pursuing the following degree options: all. Requirements: 2.5 GPA, Full time or part time student. First time freshmen are encouraged to apply.

Enrolled in at least the second year of an undergraduate program through the final year of a Master's program at the time the application is submitted to the local Zonta club or district. 3. Applicants must still be attending school at the time the scholarship funds are disbursed to receive this scholarship. 4. Must submit the Zonta International verification of current enrollment form (see page 10) with application materials. Acceptance letters are not verification of enrollment and will not be accepted. 5. Achieved an outstanding academic record during her academic studies, including business subjects. 6. Demonstrated initiative, ambition and commitment to pursuing a career in business.

SOWELA

- Through the generosity of donors in the community, the SOWELA Foundation is able to provide scholarship funds to qualified students. Awards are made on a competitive basis and the funds are limited. For first time students, the scholarship selection committee will review high school grade point average, and/or standardized test scores. For continuing students, cumulative collegiate grade point average is the primary basis for the award. Other factors for selection include community involvement, leadership positions held, honors/awards received, as well as extenuating circumstances that may warrant a need for this funding. We encourage ALL STUDENTS with a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average to submit a scholarship application by the priority date of April 1st prior to the start of the Fall semester. Students must reapply each year after January 1st to be considered.
