Testing Details (including any age requirements / accommodations)	The test is 100% online with no age restriction. Generally, freshmen through college take this test. It is based on OSHA and EPA Guidelines for Training. Students may read and/or listen to audio. The course is also available in Spanish.

*Bulletin 746, Chapter 5: All Louisiana teachers providing instruction in a course that leads to an IBC must hold the certification that they're teaching students to attain.*

Instructor Certification Requirements (by certifying agency)	Instructors must hold the S/P2 Credential in order to teach the course and must undergo yearly safety training as the certificate is good for one year. Instructors are generally automotive instructors in a face to face setting. The default passage on the exam is 80%.				
Proctoring / Test Security (if any)	Test Security is dependent upon district requirements.

Credentialing Documentation	Students may print out certificate immediately after passing exam. Some instructors print them out at the end of the semester.
