### WHAT IS THE LOUISIANA PRINCIPAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM?

The Louisiana Principal Fellowship Program partners with the National Institute for School Leaders (NISL) to offer a year-long leadership development program for school and school system leaders in all stages of their careers and school settings.

The Principal Fellowship builds participants' skills to:

- Lead and sustain transformational change
- Implement high-quality curriculum aligned to state standards
- Build a cadre of talented educators by maximizing the efforts of Content Leaders, Mentor Teachers, Intervention Content Leaders, and other staff members
- Facilitate high expectations for all students
- Continuously improve using multiple sources of data to make decisions about instruction and workforce talent aligned to Louisiana priorities

### TIMELINE


Each Cohort meets for 12 months and attains this vision over the course of 12 units (typically by August of each year).
