ACT standard time, on paper and online with accommodations and/or supports, and ACT non-college reportable materials for Testing Window 2 closes on April 19. All WorkKeys testing closes on April 19. Online student reports are now available to schools and districts in the Success system. Reports can be emailed to parents from the system.

For districts that have a non-LDOE WorkKeys realm, a <u>Data Sharing Agreement</u> (other realms) is required that allows ACT to provide data from that realm on the master WorkKeys file used for accountability. These agreements will be active until June 30, 2026.

2024-2025 CDF Funding Update

During the 2024 Jump Start Convention, the LDOE presented potential changes to the CDF list to garner feedback from school systems. The LDOE also conducted a fiscal impact analysis on the potential changes. This includes an analysis of CDF funds school systems are carrying over.

Because of the need for continued, in-depth analysis and consideration of system feedback, the CDF list will not be modified for the 2024-2025 school year. However, in the fall of 2024, the LDOE intends to publish an updated CDF list that will be implemented in the 2025-2026 school year along with a formal process for school systems to request courses to be added to the list.

Work-Based Learning Policy

Please share with administrators, CTE educators, and system leaders.

At the April 2024 meeting, BESE approved, as a Notice of Intent, updates to Bulletin 741 - Louisiana Handbook for School Administrators §3113 regarding work-based learning. The updated policy outlines clear definitions for three main forms of work-based learning: cooperative education, internships, and structured on-the-job training as part of a Registered Apprenticeship. The updates also provide enhanced qualifications for work-based learning instructors, guidelines for scheduling work-based learning activities, and provisions concerning teacher-coordinators and participating students. Further, BESE approved, as a Notice of Intent, revisions to Bulletin 111 - The Louisiana School, District, and State Accountability System incentivizing the provision of work-based learning opportunities to students.

The LDOE will be producing guidance that includes measures addressing liability and insurance concerns, adherence to child labor laws, developing new and expanding existing work-based learning programs, and engaging with business and industry.
