BELIEVE AND PREPARE UPDATES

LA PREPARATION PROVIDER LEADERSHIP COLLABORATIVE

The Department will be offering a fellowship opportunity for teacher preparation programs across the state. Deans for Impact will design and facilitate a network of program leaders from Louisiana preparation programs, who will use data to increase candidate learning in a specific focus area. Goals for the collaborative include:

- Implementing a full improvement cycle focused on candidate learning in a particular focus area
- Improving processes used to collect and analyze data for continuous program improvement
- Building trust among participants that facilitates cross-institutional learning with potential to continue beyond the initial project period

There will be limited space in the collaborative, so preparation providers interested in this opportunity must submit an application. The application to join this collaborative will be available in late June. Please contact Nicole Bono at nicole.bono@la.gov for further details.

PRAXIS SUPPORT GUIDE

Praxis is a requirement for enrollment in and completion of teacher preparation programs in Louisiana. Many prospective educators face challenges in successfully completing this requirement. School systems have demonstrated a strong desire to support those, who are interested in becoming certified to teach, and have a need for resources to assist them with this support. On June 12, the Department released the [Praxis Support Guide](#). This guide is designed to assist aspiring teachers with test preparation for the Praxis exams necessary for teacher certification.

The guide includes information about required Praxis exams for each certification area. In addition, it includes directions for creating an individualized study plan, recommendations for how to provide follow up support to someone on a study plan, and a list of test preparation resources.

BELIEVE AND PREPARE FUNDING

The 2017-2018 grant cycle is coming to a close. **All 8(g) funds must be spent by June 15, 2018**, and requests for reimbursements must be submitted in eGMS by **June 22, 2018**. **Failure to do so will result in a loss of these funds.** All federal funds (IDEA, TIF, Title I 1003(a), Title II) must be spent by September 30, 2018, and requests for reimbursements must be submitted in eGMS by November 15, 2018.

BESE will consider 2018-2019 Formula Fund allocations for preparation provider transition support on June 19, 2018. These funds will include 2018-2019 formula funds, which are based on program providers' three year average of program completers, as well as the full balance of unspent 2016-2017 8(g) funds. Providers will receive funding from a variety of sources, a small portion of which (less than 15 percent) must be spent by September 30, 2018. Preparation providers will receive an email with specific details regarding their formula fund allocations and timelines for spending these funds.

In addition, the Department will conduct a data collection process in August 2018, to determine allocations for undergraduate resident and mentor stipends for 2018-2019.

TEACHER PREPARATION QUALITY RATING SYSTEM: WEBINAR ON JUNE 15

In June 2017, BESE approved the [Teacher Preparation Quality Rating System](#), which will phase in over a period of five years. The Department is now preparing for the Learning Phase of the quality rating system, which is from 2018-2019 to 2019-2020. During this phase, all teacher preparation providers will participate in an onsite review.

The Department will hold a webinar with teacher preparation providers on Friday, June 15, 2018, at 10:00 AM regarding the Teacher Preparation Quality Rating System. Please RSVP for the webinar [here](#).

During this webinar, the Department will ask for **feedback regarding the list of high-need schools and the business rules for the quality rating system.** The Department will also give a brief demo of the Onsite Review Scheduling Portal.

The [Onsite Review Scheduling Portal](#) will open on June 18, 2018 and will close on July 16, 2018. Teacher preparation providers will submit their preferences for the academic year (2018-2019 or 2019-2020), semester, and dates during which they would like to participate in the onsite review.

TEACHER PREPARATION PROGRAM APPROVAL

APPROVED EXTENSION REQUESTS
