### **Quarterly Scholarship Enrollment**

Quarter 3 reporting for the Louisiana Scholarship Program (SEE) and School Choice Program (SCS) will open on February 1st and close on February 6th.

- If any information is incorrect or a student is missing from your roster, please contact us immediately at <a href="mailto:studentscholarships@la.gov">studentscholarships@la.gov</a> for assistance.
- If the enrollment reports are not accurate and submitted on time, it affects the student enrollment counts and delays tuition payments.
- Each school is responsible for reviewing the final quarterly enrollment report as entered in the LEADS system.

• If a student drops from your school, please follow the drop procedures so that the student can be dropped from your roster.

\*Please note that the payment report generated in LEADS does not accurately reflect final payment amounts.

Schools will have 30 days from the last day of quarterly enrollment reporting period each quarter to report any enrollment issues.

### **General Nonpublic School Office Hours**

### Jump Start Construction Scholarship Application

#### Please share with high school counselors.

The Louisiana Construction Education Foundation, Louisiana's Community and Technical College System, and the Louisiana Department of Education are now accepting applications for the <u>Jump Start Construction Connect Scholars</u> <u>Program</u>. This program is the state's first and only scholarship dedicated exclusively to Jump Start graduates who have earned a Jump Start credential and a Louisiana high school diploma. Subsequently, these students are enrolled in an LCTCS Construction Pathway Program or Associated Builders and Contractors (ABC) training program the summer or fall immediately following graduation. This scholarship will assist graduates in gaining the necessary training to earn industry employment in construction crafts fields aligned to four and five-star jobs that may lead to management positions.

Up to forty one-time scholarships will be awarded to eligible students. Applications are due April 19, 2024.

### Academic Content <u>2023-2024 Seal of Biliteracy Orders</u> Please share with data coordinators, school counselors, and school leaders.

Since the approval of <u>RS 17:273.4</u> in 2014, Louisiana students may earn the State Seal of Biliteracy by demonstrating literacy in English and another language. School systems should submit the <u>Diploma and Seal order form</u> for the 2023-2024 graduates along with the <u>Seals of Biliteracy Request Document</u>.

All diploma and seal requests must be submitted through the electronic form. The deadline to submit orders is February 2. Only one form should be completed for each school system. The LDOE will cover the costs for the initial order and distribution request that are received by the due date.

High schools with at least five percent of their graduating class earning the Seal of Biliteracy will be recognized at the June BESE meeting.
