### Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) Survey

<u>Senate Bill 12</u> of the 2023 Regular Legislative Session **requires** each elementary, middle, and high school to have an AED on its premises in an easily accessible location. It also **requires** that an AED and a trained AED user who is also trained in first-aid CPR be present at each athletic event sponsored by K-12 schools and postsecondary institutions.

Funding has been made available for the purchase of AEDs and the LDOE needs your assistance in determining the most effective method to disperse these funds. Please complete the <u>AEDs Survey</u> no later than **November 9**.

### **School Health Survey**

# Please share with health, physical education, and wellness staff and/or staff that oversee bullying and suicide prevention programs.

As required by state law, the LDOE monitors and evaluates health, recess, physical activity, and employee training in schools to provide an annual report to the Louisiana Legislature. Participation is critical to providing accurate, high-quality data to the Senate and House Committees on Health and Welfare. As such, each school should complete the <u>2023-2024 School Health Survey</u> by **November 17**.

Although information may be collected from staff that oversee physical education/health, or bullying and suicide prevention, **only one survey should be submitted per school**.
