# **Assessments, Accountability, and Analytics**

#### K-3 Literacy Screening

Please share with school leaders and test coordinators.

The deadline for requesting braille forms for the regular K-3 middle-of-year (MOY) screener has been extended to December 8. Please send any requests as soon as possible using the K-3 Literacy Screener Materials Request Form. Students who need braille will not be included in field testing.

The <u>K-3 Literacy Screener</u> link includes MOY remote administration decks by grade level (required for use with remote administrations) and online course directions for <u>leaders</u> and <u>teachers</u>.

#### Social Studies and Civics Field Testing

All students in grades 3-8 will be expected to participate in the <u>social studies field test</u> in spring 2024. All students enrolled in civics will be expected to participate in the civics field test. The times below were released to district test coordinators during the November monthly call.

Grades 3 and 4: Session 1 = 60, Session 2 = 40, and Session 3 = 60Grades 5-8 and civics: Three, 70-minute sessions (Session 1, Sessions 2a/2b, and Session 3)

Any course that a school labels "AP" must receive authorization through the <u>AP Course Audit</u>. The deadline to submit AP Course Audit materials for course authorization and renewal is January 31.

State-level applications must be submitted via an online application portal, which is now open.
