Scholarship Transfer Request 2023-24

The transfer window for the Louisiana Scholarship Program (LSP) and School Choice Program (SCP) reopened on August 1. All transfers for Quarter 1 must be completed by **August 25**.

Quarterly Scholarship Enrollment

All schools should be currently reviewing student rosters and verifying their LEADS portal access.

We strongly encourage schools to schedule an <u>Office Hour session</u> if you have any enrollment access issues, questions regarding entering enrollment or questions about a specific student's enrollment.

Quarter 1 reporting for the Louisiana Scholarship Program (SEE) and School Choice Program (SCS) must be submitted September 1-7 in order to receive tuition payments on-time.

- If any information is incorrect or a student is missing from your roster, please contact us immediately at studentscholarships@la.gov for assistance.
- If the enrollment reports are not accurate and submitted on time, it affects the student enrollment counts and delays tuition payments.
- Each school is responsible for reviewing the final quarterly enrollment report as entered in the LEADS system.
- If a student drops from your school, please follow the drop procedures so that the student can be dropped from your roster.

*Please note that the payment report generated in LEADS does not accurately reflect final payment amounts.

Schools will have **30 days** from the last day of quarterly enrollment reporting period each quarter to report any enrollment issues.

We will have a "How to Complete Quarterly Enrollment" webinar on <u>August 23 at 2 p.m.</u> for all new participating schools, new scholarship managers, and those needing additional support. This webinar will be used to provide additional support and step-by-step training for those that are learning the program.

Opening of DCAI and ACT Data Certification

The Louisiana Data Review system is now open for certification of data used in the DCAI and ACT indices that will be calculated for 2023 school performance scores. This is the final opportunity for school systems to request changes to data. All requests must have documentation. Accountability contacts were provided with directions for secure access and resources to assist them and are responsible for sharing student-level school rosters with the schools. They will provide directions for how requests with documentation are collected in their districts. All submissions must be entered into La Data Review no later than **August 29**.
