Educator Development

Retiree-Return-to-Work Guidance and Sample Certification Reinstatement Letter Please share with human resources directors and system level leaders.

The LDOE has developed a sample reinstatement letter for Louisiana educators whose teaching certificate has lapsed. The letter provides licensure options to reinstate and/or renew a Louisiana teaching certificate. School systems may use this letter to recruit past educators who are no longer in the profession to fill staffing shortages. Teachers Retirement System of Louisiana recently hosted a retiree return to work webinar to outline how recent laws work and their impact on retirees who become reemployed in positions eligible for TRSL membership. Third-Party Entity Teacher Certification

During the 2023 Regular Session, legislation was passed allowing third-party entities employing teachers to receive approval to evaluate their contracted teachers for the purposes of maintaining certification. An RFA was published, and a pilot is under way. The approval process will be outlined at the January BESE meeting and several pilot entities will be recommended for approval.
