



Louisiana Scholarship Declined Award Form

Families seeking to decline a Scholarship award for the 2022- 2023 school year must complete this form together with the awarding school. In order to request to decline an award, students must:

- Complete the current form provided by the school for the 2022-2023 school year
- Declined awards must be submitted to our office no later than May 20th.
- Once a family declines the award, they will no longer be eligible to receive a scholarship for the remainder of the 2022-23 school year.

Once the award has been removed for the 2022-23 school year, it cannot be reinstated or transferred to another participating school. If a family declines an award, they must re-apply in the fall in order to be eligible for any scholarships awarded in the upcoming years.

The family must sign this form acknowledging that they understand they are willingly choosing not to participate in the LSP program for the current school year and must reapply if they would like to be considered for any future scholarship awards.

A school representative must also sign the form acknowledging that they have informed the family of the stipulations of declining a scholarship award.
