

## Emergency Assistance for Non-Public Schools (EANS) Program Quick Reference Links

The Emergency Assistance for Non-Public School (EANS) Fund is a \$55 million Federal allocation paid to Louisiana through the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSA) signed into law on December 27, 2020.

A non-profit/non-public school is eligible to participate in this program if it is Academically Approved by the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) for school year 2019-2020 and has a Brumfield v. Dodd approval. <u>A list of eligible schools</u> is available and can be found in the Department's <u>Nonpublic Schools Library</u>.
