## NOTES

- 1. A household is defined as all immediate family members (parents and minor siblings) that reside in the home. However, it may also include any extended family members and/or guardians that have legal custody or guardianship of the student.
- 2. Income must be verified for all adults that are members of the household.
- 3. A household may provide their 2022 Federal Tax Return to verify income at the time of application. However if awarded a scholarship, the household MUST provide a 2023 Federal Tax Return at the time of registration in the Spring to confirm eligiblity.
- 4. If a household uses check stubs to verify income, the check stubs must be the last 4 consecutive check stubs (for the current year) within 60 days of the date of application.
