



Principal Track Overview

The **Teacher Leader Summit** is an annual celebration of Louisiana’s educators. **New to the Summit this year is a dedicated session track for principals who lead Comprehensive Intervention Required (CIR) and Urgent Intervention Required-Academic (UIR-A) schools.**¹ This track will equip school leaders and their leadership teams with the tools they need to support each teacher to prepare for and deliver instruction. School systems have been allocated stipends for one school leader from every CIR/UIR-A school to attend the Summit.

Principals can reserve seats in the Summit Principal Track by following these steps:

STEP 1: Principals determine which sessions to attend using the guidance laid out in the Core Track Session Worksheet below.

STEP 2: Based on the worksheet session selections, principals build their schedule and reserve seats in the Teacher Leader Summit app, available in the App Store and Google Play Store on May 3.

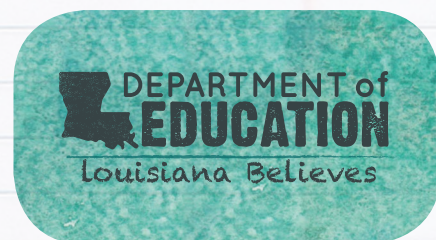
