Mentor and Resident Funding

In the 2023-2024 academic year, the data collection for Mentor compensation will take place using a similar process to what was used in 2022-2023. Those unable to join the Fall 2023 Mentor and Resident funding call to review the funding eligibility and process should review the <u>presentation</u>.

School systems must submit all required data no later than **October 20** in EdLink. All certificates required (practitioner license, resident license, Mentor credential or waiver) must be issued by **October 1** in order to be eligible for funding.

Registered Apprenticeships

In August, the Department submitted the first competency based registered apprenticeship in teaching in partnership with Tangipahoa Parish Schools and Southeastern Louisiana University to the Louisiana Workforce Commission. The apprenticeship application is expected to be approved in early September.

Once established, registered apprenticeships can leverage financial resources from the U.S. Departments of Education and Labor as well as state workforce financial resources to support this career pathway.

Geaux Teach Scholarship Program

Act 463 of the 2022 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature established the Geaux Teach Program, which provides scholarships to students who are enrolled in teacher preparation programs at the state's postsecondary institutions that are approved by the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE). Funding is also available to students attending certified alternative teacher preparation programs approved by BESE.

Students may receive up to \$5,000 annually to cover the cost of tuition fees, textbooks, and instructional materials required for enrollment. The <u>Geaux Teach Bulletin</u> with allocations for each eligible postsecondary school and provider was released on August 2.

TEACHER PREPARATION PROGRAM APPROVAL

2023-2024 Program Approval Applications in Round I Evaluations

<u>New program applications</u> are now in the evaluation stage. Applications are reviewed to ensure applicants meet all policy requirements to obtain approval. Round I pending decisions have been sent to applicants. Applicants who receive a pending denial will be given seven calendar days to resubmit their application for Round II evaluations.

The spring approval cycle, going to April BESE for consideration, opened on September 1 with the <u>Notice</u> <u>of Intent</u> stage. Notices of Intent are due October 1 for this cycle. In order to support applicants, a <u>new</u> <u>resource</u> has been added to the <u>preparation library</u>.

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TEACHER PREPARATION QUALITY RATING SYSTEM

Teacher Preparation Quality Rating System Performance Profile Release

The LDOE is currently hosting the annual Performance Profile debrief meetings with providers for the 2021-2022 Teacher Preparation Quality Rating System reports. These debrief sessions are individualized to each provider and offer insight into 2021-2022 Quality Rating Scores, as well as support for program improvement. Debrief sessions will be held until **September 22**. While the LDOE is in transition to a new hosting site, the TPQRS Performance Profiles will be found in the <u>preparation library</u>.

Teacher Preparation Onsite Review Update

The Teacher Preparation Quality Rating System (TPQRS) includes Preparation Program Experience as one of the domains. An onsite review by a third party is conducted once at least every four years to determine the <u>guality of the programs</u>.

There will be no onsite reviews this fall. The LDOE will work with each provider to determine their onsite review windows during debrief meetings.
