



The 2019 [Teacher Leader Summit](#) will take place **June 26–28, 2019**, at the Morial Convention Center in New Orleans. This annual event will bring together roughly 6,500 educators and content experts, who are focused on creating meaningful growth for every student, every day. The summit is attended by teachers, principals, superintendents, and preparation provider faculty.

**To attend Summit, participants must first register through [EventBrite](#). Then registered participants should download the Summit app and register for specific sessions to attend on each day.**

Deans/program leads will receive a special invitation to attend Summit with no registration cost. If you are a dean or program lead who has already registered for Summit, you can unregister and then re-register using the code on your invitation.
