LDOE Updates/Opportunities



Mentor Funding

School Systems received Mentor funding in mid-January. System leads also received an email with a list of Mentors eligible for funding on January 12.

If a school system did not receive funding for a Mentor the most likely reason for ineligibility is:

- The Mentor was not coded as 112, teacher.
- The Mentor did not possess the required Mentor certification or Mentor waiver by October 1, 2023.
- The resident they supported did not hold their required certification (PL or resident license) by October 1, 2023.

Pre-K Mentor Funding

Mentors coded as Pre-K teachers are not eligible for MFP Mentor funding. School systems receive funding for these Mentors through an allocation in EGMs, using 8g funding.

If a school system reported an eligible Pre-K Mentor, the system lead should have received an email following the January BESE meeting with details about accessing this funding in EGMs.



K-12 Computer Science Standards

The LDOE is now accepting <u>applications</u> for volunteers who wish to serve on the K-12 Computer Science Standards Writing Committee.

Participants will agree to:

- volunteer their time and effort without compensation, per diem, or reimbursements;
- attend in-person meetings at the Claiborne building in Baton Rouge; and
- complete asynchronous work outside of scheduled convenings.

The <u>application</u> window is now open and will close at 4 p.m. on **February 5.**



Teacher Preparation: Computer Science (5652) Praxis Exam

Registration is now open for the Energize Project. This project is open to all 6-12 public and public charter school teachers with a free 40 hour virtual training that provides

- practice praxis content materials;
- tutoring and peer learning communities; and
- feedback from computer science faculty at Southeastern Louisiana University.

Spring Program Approvals

Providers who submitted for spring approval will be receiving a pending decision letter on **February 15**.

The next cycle will open May 1. See the <u>Preparation Library</u> for program <u>approval resources</u>, including application rubrics. Programs submitting applications for review should use these materials to ensure their applications align with policy requirements.

Learning Year Evaluator Training

School systems will participate in the Learning Year during the 2024-2025 school year. The COMPASS evaluation system will not be used.

- Draft observation rubrics will be shared early 2024.
- Webinars will be held in the spring.

Face-to-face training for system and school leaders will take place this summer in nine regions across the state. Please see the <u>Louisiana Leader and Educator Rubric and Evaluation Training Guidance</u> for available dates within each region.

Teacher training will be available in August in the Professional Learning (PL) Platform. Additional resources will also be made available to systems.

High Quality Instructional Materials (HQIM)

Teacher Preparation Providers (TPPs) have identified purchasing HQIM as a financial barrier to providing quality experiences for their candidates. LDOE is guiding TPPs with the purchase and implementation of HQIM most chosen by local school systems. This assistance will help better align coursework with Birth-12 clinical experiences and more strongly prepare graduates for their Louisiana classrooms.

Deans and Directors will be receiving an email within the next few weeks with their allocation, a survey to gather information and assurances, and directions on the processes.

More information will be provided in the spring around opportunities for professional learning.

Title II Reporting Services <u>ETS portal</u> will open **February 1, 2024** in order for educator prep providers to review 2022-2023 completer data.

Please complete this review by **February 29, 2024**. Programs that need to make changes to rosters after this time period will incur a \$1,500 fee from Title II for each requested change.



Certification Reminders



Certification Policy Revisions

Policy proposed and adopted at the January BESE meeting include:

- Adoption of new exams in response to the legislative session and commission recommendations
- Alignment across bulletins or legislation, removing duplicative language, and reorganizing information
- Updated requirements for foreign equivalency transcripts
- Removal of unused or obsolete certification (EEL and Pre-PL)
- Updated OFAT renewal requirements
- Certification simplification
- Technical edits



Praxis Exam Adopted

- As a result of recommendations from the Computer Science Education Advisory Commission, the LDOE proposed and BESE adopted a Computer Science exam (5652).
- The passing score is in alignment with the ETS Multiple State Standard Setting Study recommendation of 149.
- Policy is also allowing a transitionary period where the current 30 semester hours of coursework for initial certification can be used for three years.



Literacy Exam Requirements

Beginning January 1, 2024, Out-of-State applicants, not meeting exam exemption requirements, authorized to teach grades K-3 not meeting exam requirements with experience will need to take the Teaching of Reading exam in addition to content and pedagogy exams.

Initial applicants completing **in-state** preparation programs already enrolled in the year-long residency and holding either the PL or R credential prior to **January 1, 2025** are not subject to taking the Teaching of Reading exam.

Add-on policy is effective September 1, 2024.

New Literacy Exam Option

BESE adopted the Louisiana Elementary Multiple-Subjects exam, which includes as a part of the English Language Arts subtest, the Teaching of Reading exam.

- Allows for an option with the same number of exams as currently required
- Includes grades K-3 (PK-3, 1-5, Special Education areas)
- Passing score increases over time to gradually increase Science of Reading skill mastery for teacher candidates



Add-on Literacy Requirements

For add-on purposes, general reading and literacy hours may be fulfilled with:

- The indicated semester hours
 - Successful completion of the BESE-approved <u>literacy foundations</u> <u>training</u> *may* be accepted for the number of hours approved per program
- Equivalent contact hours or
- Passing the adopted Teaching of Reading <u>exam</u>

LETRS completion certificates must be verified by <u>LouisianaLiteracy@la.gov</u> for add-on credit.

Foreign Equivalency Transcripts

New foreign equivalency transcripts requirements include that a credentialing agency must be an endorsed member in good standing with either:

- National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES)
- Association of International Credential Evaluators (AICE).

Policy is effective May 20.

Mentor Waiver

In April 2023 BESE approved a full waiver of the mentor credential for the 2023-2024 school year. Just like previous years the mentor waiver will be granted on a case-by-case basis through the application process established by the LDOE and at no cost to the applicant, school system, or teacher preparation provider.

The <u>2023-2024 Mentor Credential Waiver Application</u> opened in July. Refer to the <u>Mentor Waiver Application Guide</u> for details on completing this year's application.

The 2023-2024 Mentor waiver application portal will remain open until **June 8**, **2024**.


K-5 FLAME
