

2023 Louisiana Aspiring Educator Summer Academy Staffing Information July 10th-14th, 2023 University of Louisiana Monroe

The Louisiana Aspiring Educator Summer Academy is a one-of-a-kind, 5-day, hybrid of a summer camp and a professional development experience for high school students enrolled in the Louisiana Pre-Educator Pathway or any other coursework aimed at attracting and developing future Louisiana educators.

Hosted by the Louisiana Department of Education and staffed by a team of advisors and coaches from around the state, the Louisiana Aspiring Educator Academy will take place at the **University of Louisiana Monroe on July 10-14, 2023**.

The Aspiring Educator Summer Academy will bring together one-hundred aspiring educators from around the state for a high-energy, professional leadership development experience that propels them on their pathway to becoming highly effective, educational leaders in our state.

A general day at the academy will give participants an opportunity to engage in workshops led by extraordinary Louisiana education advocates, to be mentored by exceptional educators at various points in their career, to practice skills related to being an effective education advocate, and to network and build community with other Louisiana aspiring educators.
