

Guidance for Adverse Childhood Experiences Training

BESE policy (<u>Bulletin 741 §337</u>) requires at least one hour of annual in-service training on recognizing Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE's) and the utilization of trauma-informed education, including research-based information provided on a day that other types of in-service training will be provided. The Louisiana Department of Health (LDH), in partnership with the Louisiana Child Welfare Training Academy (LCWTA), created a one-hour webinar for school systems to utilize in providing this training to their educators. The webinar is a resource to use in meeting those requirements.

Training Guidance

School systems should develop a plan to allow employees to complete the training. If the system has certified Adverse Childhood Experiences trainers, those individuals can create and conduct the one-hour training.

Or the system can utilize virtual training from the Louisiana Child Welfare Training Academy.

- 1. If you have an account, please log into your account. If you do not have an account, please create an account.
- 2. A video has been developed if you need assistance creating an account.
- 3. Once logged in, select the site home button (top left-hand side of the screen).
- 4. Select general course category. The course has been placed next to the Mandatory Reporter course for easy access.
- 5. Select Introduction to Trauma-Informed Education to enroll in the course.
- 6. Complete the course. Download the certificate for your records.

School systems shall keep a record of who has completed the annual training.
