

PhD Science: K-2 Pilot Overview

PhD Science™ kindergarten through level 2 will be available to pilot during the 2020–2021 school year. Each level consists of four modules with a total of approximately 110 thirty-five-minute lessons. Like levels 3 through 5, each module features an authentic, knowledge-building anchor phenomenon that students explore while rigorously engaging in scientific learning. The hands-on approach of *PhD Science* allows students to interact with materials that build scientific knowledge. Modules feature high-quality texts and grade-appropriate content area connections that allow students to practice literacy and math skills in a scientific context. Each module also includes fine art as a way for all students to access and connect to art while learning about science.
